I have compiled the accompanying statement of assets, liabilities & equity – modified cash basis of Arizona Independent Scheduling Administrator Association (a nonprofit organization) as of March 31, 2008, and the related statement of income & expenses, actual & budget - modified cash basis for the quarter then ended in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The supplementary budget included in these statements is presented for supplementary analysis purposes only. The financial statements have been prepared on the modified cash basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

A compilation is limited to presenting in the form of financial statements information that is the representation of management. I have not audited or reviewed the accompanying financial statements and, accordingly, do not express an opinion or any other form of assurance on them. In addition, the supplementary budget information for the quarter ended March 31, 2008, has not been audited or reviewed by me and, accordingly, I do not express an opinion or any other form of assurance on it. However, I did become aware of departures from the cash basis of accounting described in the following paragraphs.

Management has elected to omit substantially all of the disclosures ordinarily included by the modified cash basis of accounting. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence a user's conclusions about the organization's assets, liabilities, equity, income and expenses. Accordingly, these financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.
